



Peregrinación a

Roma y Asís

5 days and 4 nights

Explore a pilgrimage in the footsteps of Saint Francis of Assisi, visiting his tomb in the Basilica. Discover the timeless history of Rome, with monuments such as the Colosseum, the Pantheon and St. Peter's Basilica.

DAY 1ST THURSDAY: CITY OF ORIGIN / ROME

Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 2 FRIDAY: CHRISTIAN ROME/VATICAN MUSEUMS CHAPEL SISTINA and SAINT PETER (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will go to the Vatican Museums to see this great collection of art and the famous Sistine Chapel, ending our visit in the impressive St. Peter's Basilica. In the afternoon we will visit Christian Rome, we will visit the Major Basilicas of Santa María, San Juan de Letrán and San Pablo Outside the Walls. Accommodation.

DAY 3 SATURDAY: ROME / ASSISI / ROME (AD)

Breakfast. Early we will leave for the city of Assisi, to see the medieval city where Saint Francis lived. We will start with the Basilica of Santa María de los Ángeles, where the porziuncola, the first Franciscan church, is located. Next we will visit the church of Santa Clara, where we can pray at the tomb of the Saint who was a friend of San Francisco and then we will cross the city through the Plaza de Ayuntamiento to reach the Basilica of San Francisco, where the Tomb of the Saint is and a impressive artistic set. We can also visit the tomb of Blessed Carlos Acutis, a young Italian recently beatified and who has given a testimony of Faith in our days. Return to Rome and accommodation.

DAY 4TH SUNDAY: PAPAL BLESSING - ANGELUS - BAROQUE ROME E IMPERIAL (AD)

Breakfast. We will head towards St. Peter's Square, where traditionally every Sunday, at noon, the Pope prays the Angelus and gives the blessing to those attending. We will continue our visit to Baroque Rome with a walk through its main squares such as the Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, the Pantheon or Piazza Navonna. In the afternoon our visit heads to the Colosseum to begin the tour of Imperial Rome where we will tour the surroundings of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Piazza di Venezia, with its impressive Monument to the Fatherland and the Piazza del Campidoglio. Back to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 5: MONDAY: ROME/ CITY OF ORIGIN (AD)

Breakfast. Airport transfer. End of our services.
