



Peregrinación a

Santuarios Marianos

9 days and 8 nights

Discover the unique Marian route, visiting sanctuaries in Fátima, Lourdes, Loyola, Torreciudad, Zaragoza and Santiago de Compostela. A spiritual journey that combines culture and devotion, attracts thousands of pilgrims.

DAY 1: MADRID / CORIA / FÁTIMA

Departure towards Coria where upon arrival we will make a brief stop in the city.

In the city of Coria one of the most important relics of Christianity is kept, which according to tradition was the tablecloth where the Last Supper of Christ was celebrated, before his Passion, origin of the Church and the institution of the Holy Mass. . Then we will continue to Fátima. Upon arrival we will be able to participate in the Holy Rosary, Mass and the Candle Procession (*see note). Accommodation.

DAY 2: FÁTIMA / ALJUSTREL / FÁTIMA (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will do the Via Crucis along the Valihos road from the little shepherds' roundabout to the small town of Aljustrel, where we can visit the houses of the little shepherds with a local guide. In the afternoon we will visit the Sanctuary with time to attend the religious ceremonies. Candle Procession. Accommodation.

DAY 3: FÁTIMA / PORTO / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (AD)

Breakfast. Departure to Porto, where upon arrival we will visit this beautiful Portuguese city with a local guide. We will be able to see the Don Luis I bridge, the Church of Commerce, the Church of San Francisco among other emblematic monuments. In the afternoon we will continue our pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela. Arrival and accommodation.

DAY 4: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will visit the city of Santiago with a local guide, we will pass through its most traditional streets of the old town to see its traditional architecture and through the historic center where the most famous monuments are located such as the Hostal de los Reyes Católicos, Pazo Raxoi, San Xerome School, San Martín Monastery, Antealtares, Casa del Cabildo, etc. Afterwards we will continue towards the Cathedral with its impressive exterior facades and its 4 monumental Plazas: Obradoiro, Platerías, Quintana de Mortos and Azabachería. Free time to attend the Pilgrim's Mass and venerate the tomb of Santiago, as all pilgrims who arrive in Santiago de Compostela do.

Accommodation.

DAY 5: SANTIAGO / COVADONGA / LOYOLA (AD)

Breakfast. Departure to Covadonga to visit this beautiful Sanctuary located in a place of great natural beauty located in the Picos de Europa. A very important sanctuary for the history of Spain and Christianity in Europe as a Marian pilgrimage center, where the Basilica and the Holy Cave with the image of the Virgin of Covadonga are located. Continuation towards Loyola. Accommodation.

DAY 6: LOYOLA / SAN SEBASTIAN / LOURDES (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will visit Loyola, we will visit the House-Castle where Saint Ignatius of Loyola was born and lived his early years and the Baroque Basilica built by the Jesuit Order. Then we will continue to San Sebastián to take a walk through the old town, La Concha Beach, the Buen Pastor Cathedral, the City Hall area and the rest of the heritage of this historic city. In the afternoon we will leave for Lourdes. Arrival and accommodation. At night we can make a first visit to the cave where the Virgin appeared and participate in the Torch Procession (from Easter to October).

DAY 7: LOURDES (AD)

Breakfast. We will dedicate this day to getting to know the Sanctuary of Lourdes in depth with a local guide. We will visit the Basilica of Saint Pius We will also have time to leave the Sanctuary and discover the most significant places in the life of Saint Bernadette, such as the mill where she lived with her family, the prison where she had to live for a while or the Parish where she attended. In the afternoon we will enjoy free time to continue with the visits on our own. Accommodation.

DAY 8: LOURDES / TORRECIUDAD / ZARAGOZA (AD)

Breakfast. In the morning we will leave for the Sanctuary of Torreciudad, where we will be able to see the audiovisual that they have created to welcome pilgrims and the video mapping that highlights the spectacular altarpiece that presides over the Basilica and the galleries dedicated to the Virgin Mary. In the afternoon we will continue our trip to Barbastro, to visit the Museum of the Claretian Martyrs. Continuation of the trip to Zaragoza. Accommodation.

DAY 9: ZARAGOZA / MADRID (Breakfast)

Breakfast. Free morning to walk around the city and see its monuments such as the Palacio de la Alfarería, a monument declared a World Heritage Site that reflects the splendor of the Muslim kings who inhabited it, and the Basilica del Pilar, the first Marian Sanctuary in History. In the afternoon departure to Madrid, arrival and end of our services.

GRADES:

- The procession of the Candles in Fátima takes place daily from April to October, and only on Saturdays from November to March. (subject to weather conditions)
- The Torch Procession in Lourdes takes place daily from April to October.
During the winter from November 7 to 9
April, a Rosary is prayed with torches in the Grotto of the Apparitions, on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays at 8:30 p.m.
- Pilgrim's Mass in Santiago subject to confirmation of schedules.
- Consult itinerary with departure from other cities.
- Prices subject to availability and group formation of 15 passengers, departure will be confirmed 40 days before departure with the exact number of passengers.

THE PRICE INCLUDES:

- Bus or minibus throughout the route.
- 8 nights' stay in the selected or similar hotels on a bed and breakfast basis.
- Visits of Fátima, Porto, Santiago de Compostela and Lourdes with local guide in Spanish.
- Entrance to the House of Loyola.
- Group registration in Lourdes.
- Entrance to Torreciudad-Video.
- Accompanying guide in Spanish throughout the pilgrimage. (departure with a minimum of 15 pilgrims).
- Accompanying priest or presbyter, for religious/eucharistic activities from 20 passengers.
- Basic travel insurance without cancellation. (See travel insurance supplement that includes cancellation fees, extended medical coverage and COVID).

DAY 2: MADRID (AD)

Breakfast. Panoramic tour of the beautiful and cosmopolitan capital of Madrid, visit (without tickets) to the main places of tourist interest, we will see monuments such as the impressive Cybele, Prado Museum, the Puerta de Alcalá, etc. (Minimum 4 passengers). Free afternoon. Accommodation.
